**M**rs. Bonnie Robinette Wallace, 78, of Kannapolis, died Wednesday, May 7, 2008, at CMC-NorthEast.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Saturday, May 10, 2008, at Centerview Baptist Church. The Rev. Willie Rash and her brother, the Rev. Ralph Robinette, will officiate. Interment will follow at Carolina Memorial Park.

The family will receive friends from 6 to 8 p.m. Friday, May 9, 2008, at Lady's Funeral Home.

Born August 10, 1929 in Cabarrus County, she was the daughter of the late Royal Ralph Robinette and Kathleen Safrit Robinette.
